**Novice Rams**

- Class 17 Novice ram lamb born after 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021 (open to horns)
- Class 18 **The Lindsay Wright Memorial Class PDCW Region** Novice ram under 1½ years shorn (open to Horns) *to be prepared and handled by owner.*

***Open / Senior Rams***

- Class 19 Performance ram under 1½ years old. Machine shorn not more than 28 days and not less than 7 days prior to judging. Birth dates must be included, April May drop. Rams will be scanned for fat depth and eye muscle upon arrival. Points will be allocated for these traits as well as the official allocating points for breed type. Cannot be drawn from other classes.
- Class 20 Lambplan Ram under 1 ½ years, shorn.  
Born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April in the year prior to the Show.  
The Office to be notified of entry tag numbers, no later than 1<sup>st</sup> June.  
Lambplan Assessment:  
TCP Index The difference between the highest and lowest index will be doubled and allocated to the judge for selective judging points. These points will be added to the individual entrant's index to give a total score.
- Class 21 Lambplan Pair  
Born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April in the year prior to the Show.  
The Office to be notified of entry tag numbers, no later than 1<sup>st</sup> June.  
Lambplan Assessment:  
TCP Index The difference between the highest and lowest index will be doubled and allocated to the judge for selective judging points. These points will be added to the individual entrant's index to give a total score.
- Class 22 **Brien Freebairn Memorial Trophy** Ram under 1½ years old woolly
- Class 23 **Gererdan Trophy Ram** under 1½ years shorn. Not more than 2 cm wool
- Class 24 Restricted Class: Ram under 1 ½ years shorn. Not more than 2cm wool. To be eligible studs must have no more than 100 ewes.
- Class 25 **Balmoral Trophy** Ram under 1½ years old. Machine shorn not more than 28 days and no less than 7 days prior to judging. STRICTLY NO TRIMMING (OM)  
*The trophy was presented by WS Martin & Son and an investment is held by the NSW State Committee. The trophy to the value of the accrued interest shall be awarded to the exhibitor who gains first in the class on three occasions, not necessarily in succession, after which it shall recommence.*
- Class 26 Pair rams under 1½ years shorn. Not more than 2 cm wool
- Class 27 Pair rams under 1½ years old. Machine shorn not more than 28 days and not less than 7 days prior to judging. STRICTLY NO TRIMMING

### **Intermediate Rams**

- Class 28            Performance Ram Born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020 Milk tooth. Machine shorn not more than 28 days and not less than 7 days prior to judging. Birth dates must be included, drop. Rams will be scanned for fat depth and eye muscle upon arrival. Points will be allocated for these traits as well as the official allocating points for breed type. Cannot be drawn from other classes.
- Class 29            Ram born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020, Milk tooth shorn, not more than 2 cm wool.
- Class 30            Ram, born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020 Milk Tooth, bare shorn. Machine shorn not more than 28 days and no less than 7 days prior to judging, no trimming.
- Class 31            Pair of rams, born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> June 2020, Milk Took up to 2cm wool.

### **Junior / Spring Drop Rams**

- Class 32            Performance ram dropped on or after 1<sup>st</sup> August 2020, Machine shorn not more than 28 days and not less than 7 days prior to judging. Birth dates must be included Rams will be scanned for fat depth and eye muscle upon arrival. Points will be allocated for these traits as well as the official allocating points for breed type. Cannot be drawn from other classes.
- Class 33            Ram woolly dropped on or after or on 1 August 2020.
- Class 34            Ram, shorn, not more than 2 cm wool and dropped on or after 1<sup>st</sup> August.2020
- Class 35            Pair of rams, shorn, no more than 2 cm wool and dropped on or after 1<sup>st</sup> August 2020.
- Class 36            **Symbah Trophy** Ram lamb dropped after 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021.

Novice: excludes any stud who has previously won first place ribbon in any class at a major show or a champion ribbon at a regional show. If clarification is required, please contact secretary or chief steward.

Classes 19, 25 ,28 ,32 . will attract an additional \$5 fee per entry.

Sheep can be entered into one class only.
